What Are You Living for?

The Bible says, “*But people who want to get rich keep falling into temptation. They are trapped by many stupid and harmful desires, which drown them in destruction and ruin.*” (1Ti 6:9 GW). If you are living to please men, you will end up living with insecurity for the rest of your life.

Living for God instead of money is a significant choice to prioritize spiritual and eternal values over material wealth. This approach brings true fulfillment and contentment, as it acknowledges that our ultimate purpose is to know, love, and serve God. It shifts our focus to eternal values, recognizing

that our time on Earth is a brief part of our eternal existence. Living for God frees us from materialism, allowing us to use money and possessions as tools for God's purposes. This fosters generosity and compassion towards others, as we recognize our resources are gifts from God and are called to be good stewards.

Finally, living for God guarantees success, prosperity, peace, health, security, and, above all, eternal life. Jesus said, “*But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.*” (Mat 6:33 KJV).
