Heaven or hell: choose your destination

Mat 7:13 Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat:

Life is a profound journey with a definite beginning and an eventual end. Yet, the end is merely the commencement of an eternal existence. It is a journey into eternity, where every moment of our earthly life serves as an investment towards an everlasting harvest.

One of the greatest privileges bestowed upon every human being is the power to choose their eternal abode. This fleeting life is the sole opportunity given to determine our destination after death.

The most unfortunate of all individuals is the one who limits their aspirations solely to this world. As Paul reminds us in 1 Corinthians 15:19, those who anchor their hope in Christ only for this temporal life are the most miserable. Therefore, it is crucial to acknowledge that heaven and hell are genuine realities.

The Holy Threat: The Consequences of Rejecting Salvation

Mar 16:16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

Though the gospel of Jesus Christ is a message of hope, rejecting it brings dreadful consequences. Salvation is not a casual choice, but rather the pivotal decision that determines whether one escapes hell or not. It is a holy threat, a call to make the right choice.

Salvation is not a commodity to be bargained or enticed with (1 Corinthians 2:4). Any attempts to allure people into salvation with shallow motivations are misguided. The only escape from eternal death in hell is through accepting the gospel and embracing eternal life in heaven.

Disregarding the gospel of Jesus and rejecting salvation leads to everlasting anguish, torment, and death in hell. It is sobering to realize that some may go through hellish experiences in this world yet still end up in eternal damnation, while others may

enjoy riches and pleasures but ultimately choose either heaven or hell. Rejecting salvation places one under eternal condemnation.

You can't serve two masters

Mat 6:24 "No one can serve two masters. He will hate the first master and love the second, or he will be devoted to the first and despise the second."
(GW)

Many claims to be born again while continuing to live in sin. This is an incongruity! As Romans 6:1-2b clarifies, grace does not grant license to persist in sin, for salvation is a product of grace (Ephesians 2:8). Continuously living in sin as a believer is a fast track out of salvation and into damnation.

1 John 3:8 makes it clear that those who habitually live in sin belong to the devil. Claiming to be born again yet engaging in acts such as fornication, adultery, lying, stealing, and others, aligns one with the devil. Such individuals, being the property of the devil, are destined for hellfire (Matthew 25:41).

It is impossible to be saved and continue in habitual sin. God cannot be deceived.

How do you determine your destination?

Each individual has the power to determine their eternal destiny. God has not predestined anyone for heaven or hell; rather, it is our own choices that determine our destination. Therefore, to be certain of our eternal abode, we must understand the qualifications for both heaven and hell.

#1: Qualification for Hell: Sin

Rev 21:8 But cowardly, unfaithful, and detestable people, murderers, sexual sinners, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars will find themselves in the fiery lake of burning sulfur. This is the second death." (GW)

The primary qualification for hell is sin. Every act of disobedience to God, whether through action or thought, can lead a person to hell. Engaging in various forms of disobedience attracts God's anger, and hell becomes the manifestation of His wrath.

Disobedience takes many forms, including sexual sins, lying, denial of faith, indulgence in vices, idolatry, and more (Galatians 5:20-21).

#2 Qualification for Heaven: Selfless Attraction to God

Mat 19:29 And every one that hath forsaken houses, or brethren, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife, or children, or lands, for my name's sake, shall receive an hundredfold, and shall inherit everlasting life.

To qualify for heaven requires a selfless attraction to God. Confessing Jesus as Lord and Savior is just the starting point; forsaking all to follow Him unconditionally is essential to securing a place in heaven. True salvation goes beyond mere confession; it demands the complete denial of self and unwavering dedication to follow Christ. Those who prioritize heavenly desires over worldly pursuits and truly love God are the ones welcomed into eternity (Colossians 3:1-4).

You can make the choice

Deu 30:19 I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live:

Today is your day of salvation, and the choice is in your hands. Now is the accepted time; tomorrow may be too late. Why choose hell when you have the opportunity to embrace heaven? Consider that this moment could be your last. Therefore, don't merely confess Jesus as Lord and Savior; make a resolute determination to live the rest of your life wholly committed to Him. My prayer is that this word will not stand as an accusation against you on the last day but will instead vindicate you. Amen.
